Course Credit Awarded for Cambridge AICE (British A-Level) Examinations

Central Florida Community College welcomes a variety of students of all ages to our campuses. Many students bring a depth of knowledge to specific subjects. We recognize and honor such knowledge by awarding credit for AICE examinations. Section 1007.27 (2), Florida Statutes, requires the Articulation Coordinating Committee (ACC) to establish passing scores and course and credit equivalents for AICE exams. Public community colleges and universities in Florida are requested to follow the ACC’s recommendation concerning their AICE examination policies. Credit awarded by exam may not duplicate other credit. Institutions may not award credit for scores below those listed by the ACC. CFCC students may satisfy up to 45 semester hours of course credit through any combination of credit by examination (e.g., CLEP, AP, &/or IB). **Score minimums, credit hours awarded, and course equivalencies awarded are subject to change for any examination without prior notice.**
