Course Credit Awarded for DANTES Subject Standardized Tests (DSST) Examinations

Central Florida Community College welcomes a variety of students of all ages to our campuses. Many students bring a depth of knowledge to specific subjects. We recognize and honor such knowledge by awarding credit for Defense Activity of Non-Traditional Educational Support (DANTES) examinations. Unlike other credit by examination programs, DANTES Subject Standardized Tests are not built around curriculum, but rather are designed to test students' knowledge on a variety of college-level subjects, regardless of where they may have learned the material. Section 1007.27 (2), Florida Statutes, requires the Articulation Coordinating Committee (ACC) to establish passing scores and course and credit equivalents for DANTES exams. Public community colleges and universities in Florida are required to award credit for AP, IB, CLEP, DANTES, AICE and Excelsior College exams as designated. Credit awarded by exam may not duplicate other credit. Institutions may not award credit for scores below those listed by the ACC. CFCC students may satisfy up to 45 semester hours of course credit through any combination of credit by examination (e.g., CLEP, AP, &/or IB). **Score minimums, credit hours awarded, and course equivalencies awarded are subject to change for any examination without prior notice.**
