

Dual Enrollment Registration Deadline for Public and Private Schools

Students who wish to dual enrollment at CFCC must have an application, high school transcripts or grade history report, and eligible (passing all sections) copies of original test scores to Katie Stephenson, the Dual Enrollment Coordinator, by one of our two application deadlines. The dual enrollment application can be found on our website <http://www.cf.edu/departments/sa/dual.htm> by scrolling to the bottom of the page and clicking on "Brochure with Application". A high school guidance counselor can also request paper copies to be sent to your high school.

General Marion County Information: Returning students will register on priority registration day. Returning students will be registered by our advisors on a first come, first served basis from 9am to 12pm and new applicants will be registered from 2pm to 4pm. Students will be allowed to sign in starting at 7:30am and they must be present to sign in. They must have their signed blue forms (public school students) or permission letters (private and home school students) with them when signing in. Students must select the section number for the desired classes and an alternate option in case the course is full.

If a student qualifies and turns in an application by the final registration deadline, they will register on the final registration day at 9am. If a student is retesting in one area and qualifies sometime between the priority deadline and the final deadline, they will still register on the final registration day.

General Citrus and Levy Information: Registration slips for the classes on the high school campus will be sent to the guidance counselors after the application deadline once the course offerings have been approved by the county's CFCC administrator. Registration for both on-campus and CFCC campus classes will be done through the mail on the posted priority registration date.
