

Dual Enrollment Registration Deadline for Public and Private Schools

Students who wish to enter the dual enrollment at CF must have an application, high school transcripts or grade history report, and eligible (passing all sections) copies of original test scores to Katie Stephenson, the Dual Enrollment Coordinator, by one of our two application deadlines as seen below. A high school guidance counselor can also request paper copies to be sent to your high school.

General Marion County Information: Returning students will register on priority registration day. Returning students will be registered by our advisors on a first come, first served basis from 9am to 12pm. Students will be allowed to sign in starting at 7:30am and they must be present to sign in. They must have their signed blue forms (public school students) or permission letters (private and home school students) with them when signing in. New applicants will be registered from 2pm to 4pm and can begin signing in at 1:30pm. All students must select the section number for the desired classes and an alternate option in case the course is full.

If a student qualifies and turns in an application after the priority date, but before the final registration deadline, they will register on the final registration day at 9am. If a student is retesting in one area and qualifies sometime between the priority deadline and the final deadline, they will still register on the final registration day. If a student qualifies for the priority application deadline but the student or parent is unable to attend registration day, they must register on the make up/final registration day or call for an appointment after the final/make up registration day.

General Citrus and Levy Information: Registration spreadsheets for the classes on the high school campus will be sent to the guidance counselors after the application deadline once the course offerings have been approved by the county's CF administrator. Registration for both on-campus and CF campus classes will be done through e-mail on the posted priority registration date.
