Admission Requirements for the B.S. in ECE Degree are:

- Prerequisites of: EDF 2005, EDF 2085, EME 2040;
- GPA of 2.5 or higher;
- and a passing score on the General Knowledge (GK) Exam.

Successful completion of the degree^ program will result in prek-primary teacher certification with endorsements in reading and prekindergarten disabilities; and eligibility for the ESOL endorsement.
