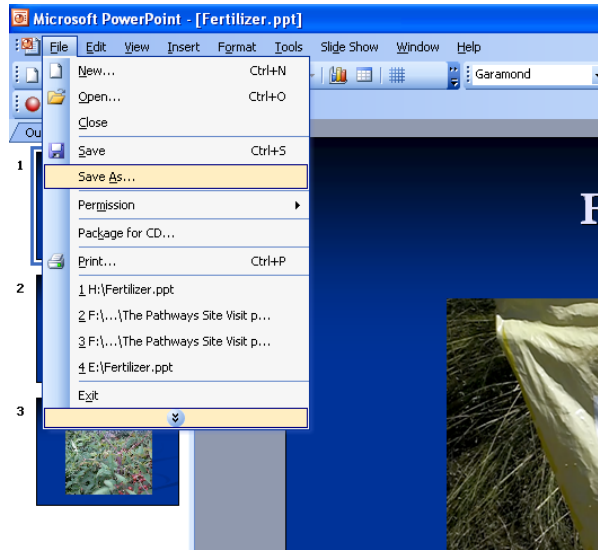
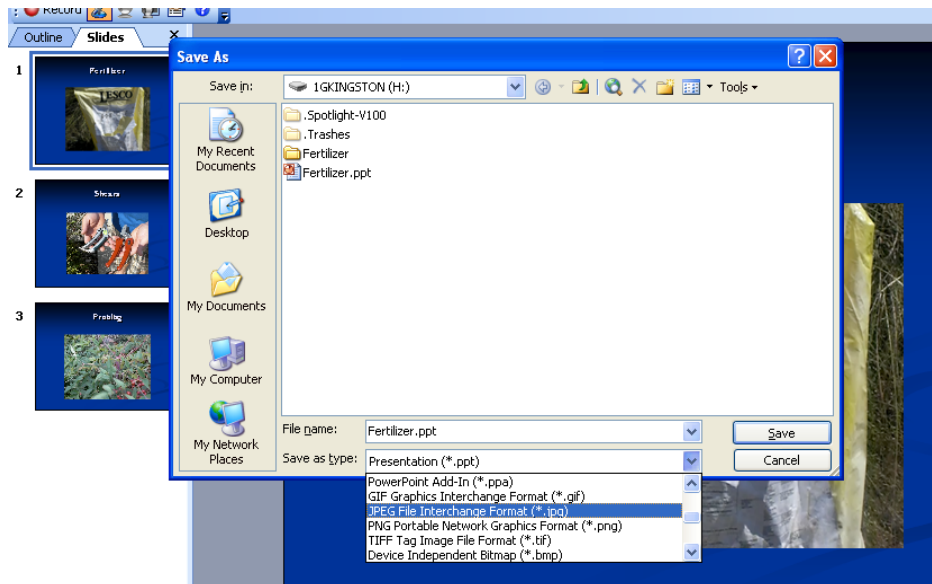


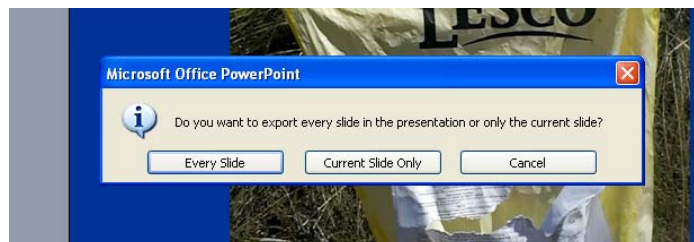
PowerPoint 2 Podcasting using Microsoft Movie Maker



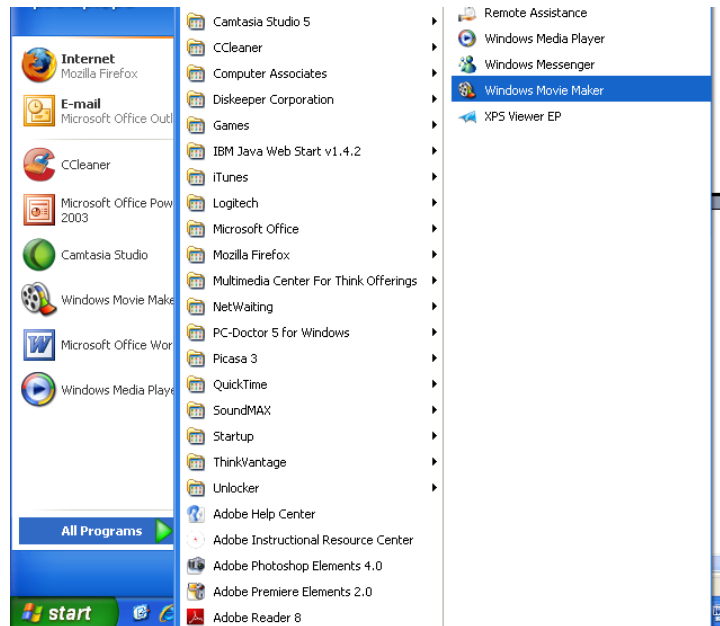
1. Open your PowerPoint presentation and select Save As from the File Menu.



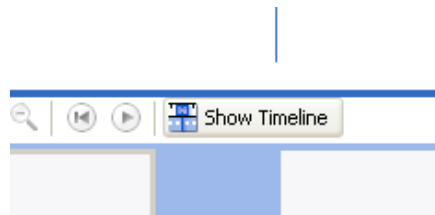
2. Select JPG from the Save as Type drop down menu.



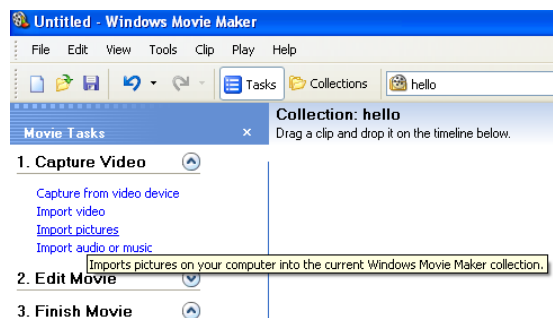
3. Choose Every Slide from the options available.
4. Close PowerPoint and Start Windows Movie Maker.



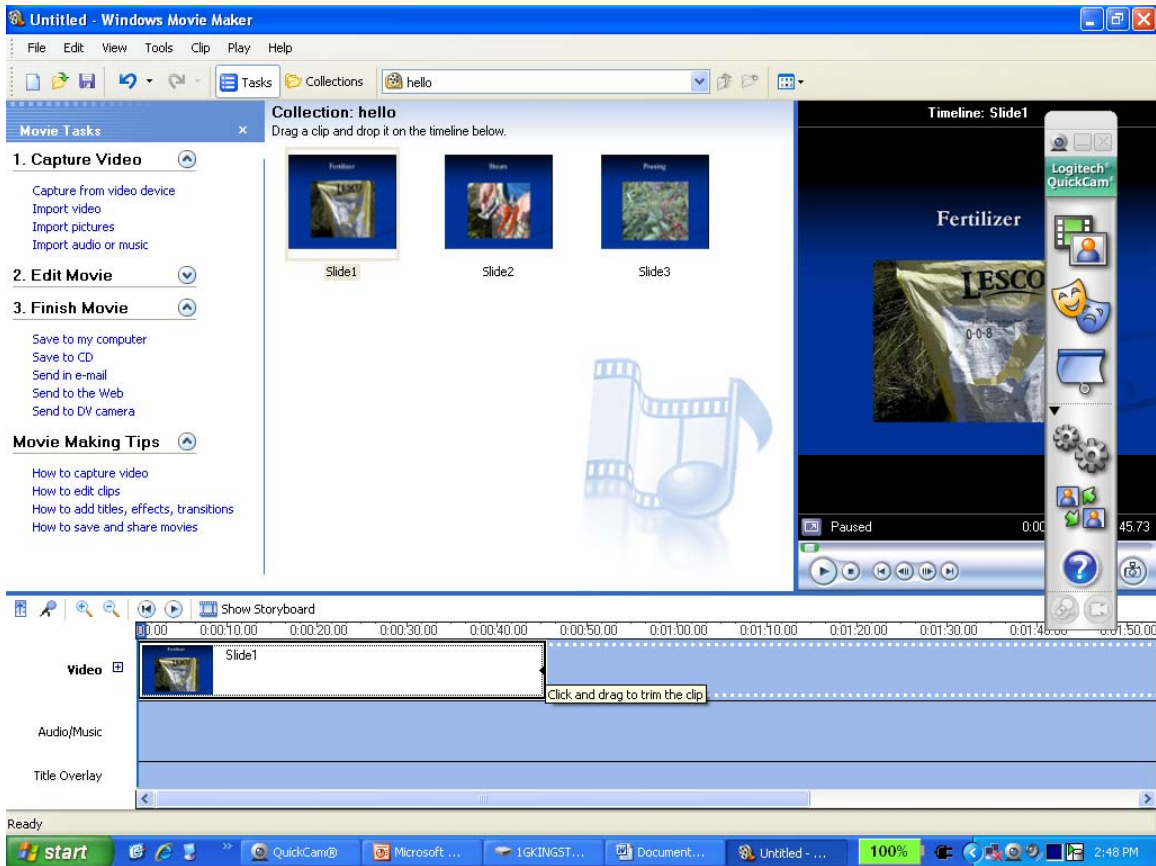
5. If not already shown, choose the timeline mode.



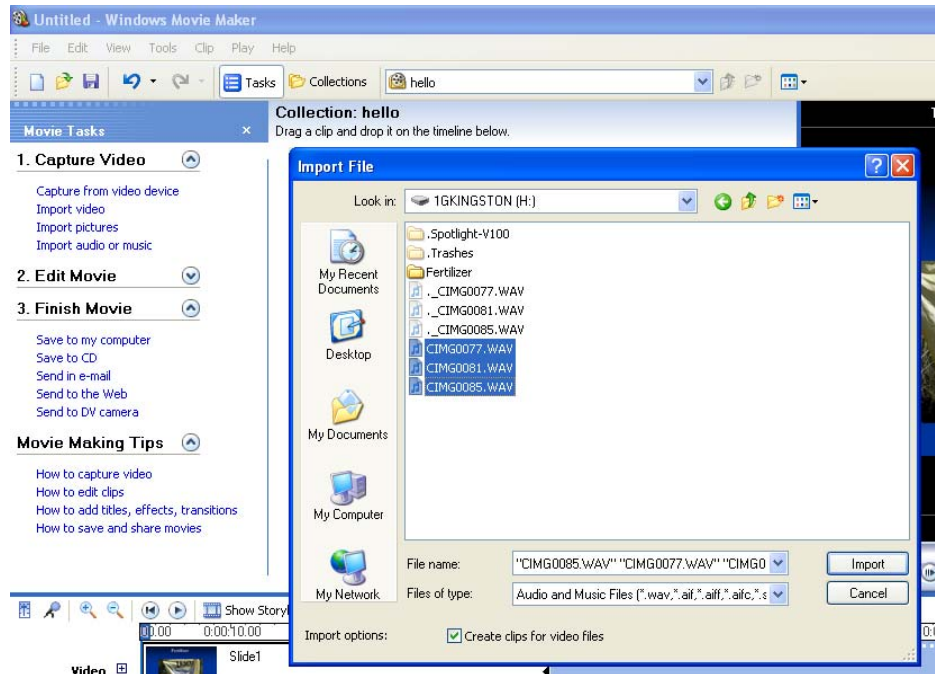
6. Import the files you converted to JPG from your PowerPoint presentation.



7. If you cannot see the Import Pictures options, click on the Tasks button.

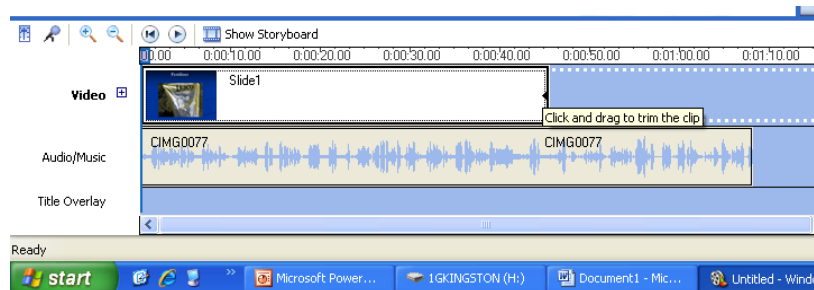


8. Drag the first slide to the timeline.
9. With your cursor, hover over the black triangle at the end of the clip and drag to the right. (as a default, Movie Maker only provides 5 seconds of screen time for each slide. By grabbing the triangle and dragging right, you can extend the time you want the slide to be on the screen.)

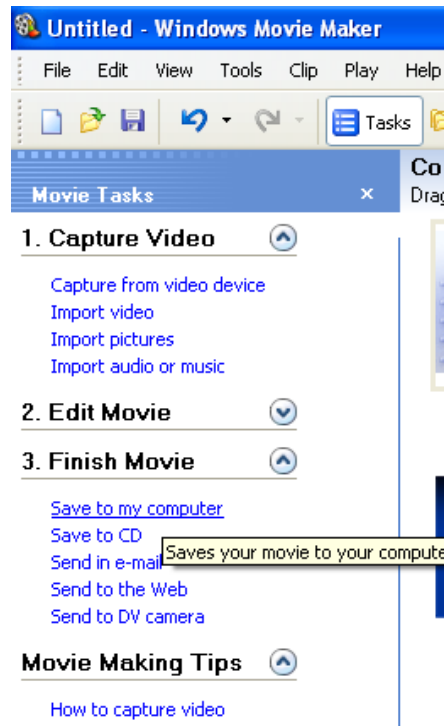


10. Import your audio (pre-recorded lecture) or click on the microphone button.

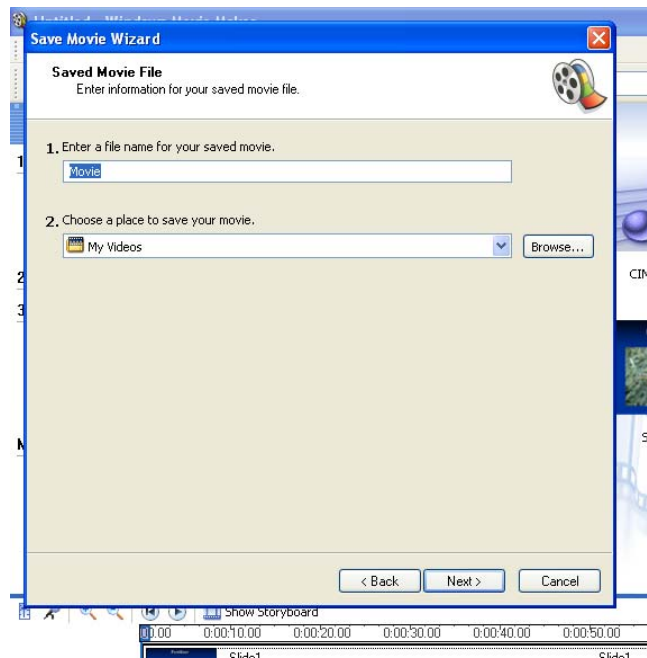

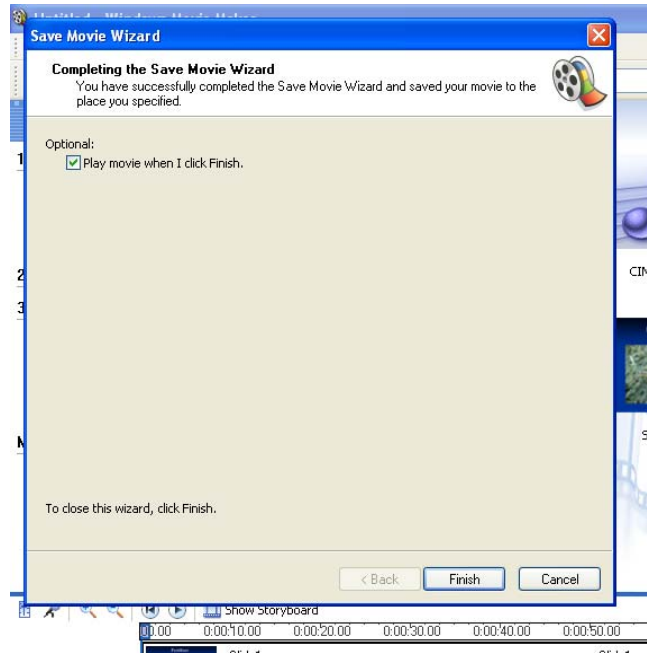
11. Adjust the length of your slide to match the length of the audio.
12. Add additional slides and audio to the timeline.



13. When finished, select the Save to my computer options.



14. Name your video then click next, next when prompted.



15. Click finish and you are done.
16. The file will be located in My Videos.
